- OMM Soccer late registration for the Fall 2015 season is open - we look forward kicking off to our 53rd season! If you have not registered yet please visit the homepage website [www.ommsoccer.org](http://www.ommsoccer.org) and click the Late Registration for Fall Soccer link. **New this year is a special Kiddie Kicker program for 3 & 4 year olds.** This relaxed and fun program soccer will introduce young children to soccer and help prepare them for a comfortable transition when they are old enough to join our Tykes program and play on a team.
- BuddyBall Sports finished up its 10<sup>th</sup> season with Track & Field at Tappan Zee High School. With the ongoing support of numerous volunteers in our community, including the Pearl River and South Orangetown School Districts and Albertus Magnus High School, this program is able to support soccer, basketball and track & field with hundreds of players and buddies annually.
- World Class FC ended its 5th season with the addition of a new Orangetown-based segment to our program that will start in Fall 2015. The response to this new program has been strong with 12 new teams formed (ages 5 to 13) and more than 180 Orangetown residents participating on the new teams. In total, the travel program now has more than 450 Orangetown residents playing for World Class FC. We will be announcing another expansion of this program later this year for high school age players from ages 14 to 18. - Our partnerships with other youth sports groups in the community are expanding as we share the same vision for investment in new programs and field development.
  - Orangetown Lacrosse and OMM Soccer continue to work on a cooperative basis, which allows the programs to share space at the existing sports complex and work together on a business plan to build more fields.
  - OMM Soccer will soon be announcing details for a new sports program to launch in the Fall 2015. Working with members of the local Orangetown high school soccer and comparison athletic programs, we are excited to bring in more volunteers to help expand our programs and also assist with field development at RPC.
- Recent field improvements at the sports complex (100% financed by OMM Soccer with **ZERO taxpayer funding**) are now complete and we continue to pay for the vast majority of the annual operating expenses at the complex so there is no burden on the local taxpayers each year. To date **OMM Soccer has invested more than \$3.5 million into the complex.**
- To support the growth in our programs, we are dedicating more resources to building additional multi-purpose athletic fields for soccer and lacrosse at RPC. New fields will be developed by OMM and its partners with **ZERO taxpayer funding**. Our business plan calls for the purchase of land at fair market value from the Town and no money from the Town for development of the fields. These new fields will be 100% privately funded. This will give the Town much needed capital to work to demolish the existing buildings at RPC that have clearly blocked new development proposals for more than 10 years now.
- We recognize that youth sports has grown into a big business in many communities, so financial accountability to our customers is a key component of our culture. You trust us with your hard earned money and you deserve transparency in our financial reporting. OMM is a financially transparent, professionally managed youth sports organization which is supported by a broad range of volunteers. OMM is a registered 501(c)3 entity with the Internal Revenue Service, we prepare an audited financial statement each year and we file Federal and State tax returns. All of these documents are submitted to the Town Board.
